CALL FOR ENTRIES

Rules

- Filmmakers of any age can enter.
- Only short original films (maximum time of 10 minutes) and/or original music videos (maximum time of 5 minutes) will be accepted.
- If the film or music video is in a language other than English, it must be subtitled.
- Only two entries per person, all films submitted may not be selected for screening at the film festival.
- Only films suitable for a general audience (G) will be accepted.
- No work-in-progress will be accepted. Finished films only.
- Title pages and credits must be included in your film.
- The public library reserves the right to post the films that are submitted on the library's website.

Submission Materials:

- Complete entry form.
- Two copies on DVD. They **must** be playable on a regular DVD player and will be kept by the library.

All submissions must be received by March 26, 2010

Award selection & prizes

- Films will be screened in April at the Homegrown Film Festival in City Council Chambers. Winners will be selected by audience members. Filmmakers are asked to be present.
